*The following amendment, relevant to **Section 5.71 – Custom Homes: Specific Architectural Design Requirements – Exterior Equipment, Utilities, Meters, A/C Units, etc. - Irrigation Controls** of the March, 2010 edition of the RVR Master Design Guidelines, was reviewed and unanimously approved by the RVR Design Review Committee on August 25, 2014.*


Section 5.71 – Custom Homes: Specific Architectural Design Requirements – Exterior Equipment, Utilities, Meters, A/C Units, etc. - Irrigation Controls

Subsection 5.71 will be amended to include the following sentences: “All Irrigation controllers must be installed on the exterior of the building and must be accessible at all times. All Irrigation systems installed after the date of this Amendment must be equipped with a wireless Hunter RainClick weather sensor or other weather sensors as reviewed and approved by the Design Review Committee or their designee. In-ground, soil moisture content sensing devices may also be considered.


The RVR Design Guidelines may be amended from time to time by the Board of Directors.
